





PRINCIPAL MESSAGE



BRIDGE COURSE ACTIVITY



WELCOMING FIRST DAY




STAFF MEETING





Welcome to this edition of our school newspaper! As the editorial board, we are proud to bring you stories, opinions, and creative voices that reflect the energy and spirit of our school community.


