CCA refers to activities that complement the academic curriculum. These activities are designed to enhance learning outcomes, promote personal growth, and develop essential life skills.




ADD ON VALUE COURSE




Coding classes are an excellent way to introduce students to the world of computer programming and develop essential skills in the digital age.





The old man smiled and said, "Just like the stone, let go of your worries and troubles. They will disappear, and you will find inner peace."




