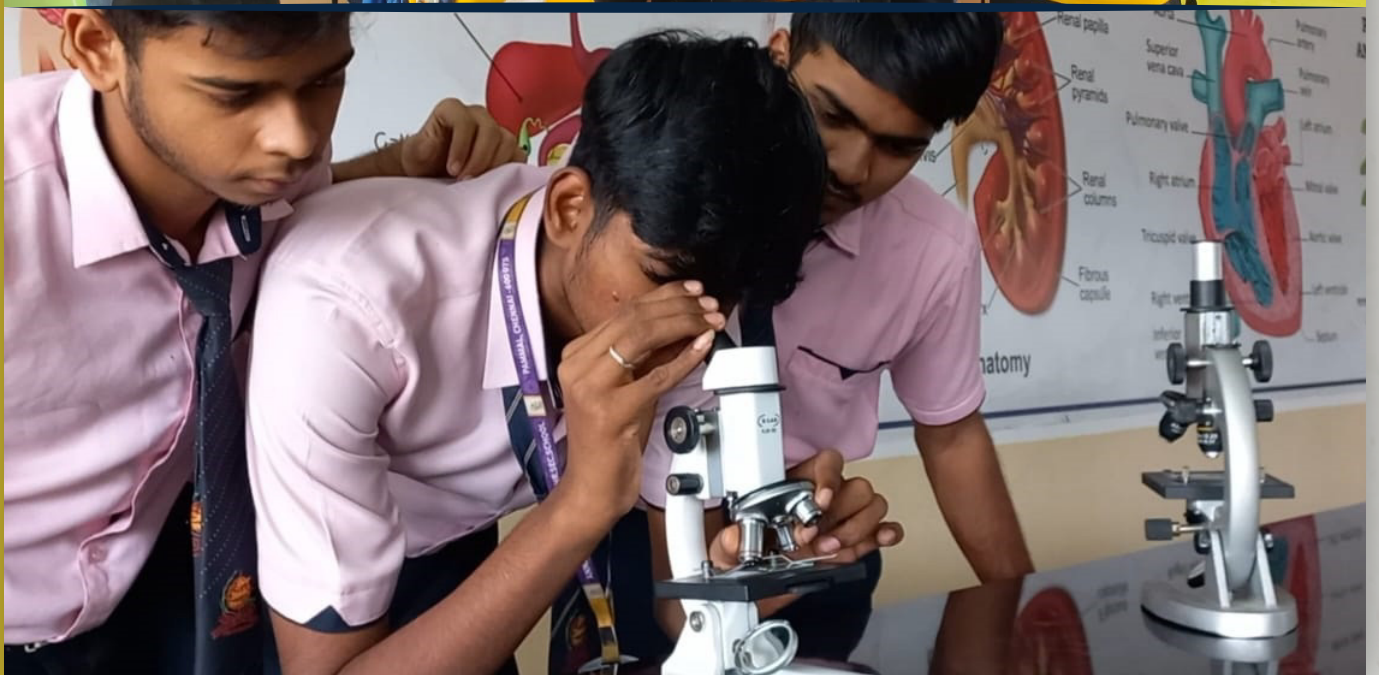

## PRIMARY SCHOOL (GRADE I – V)

In keeping with the rich and varied imagination of the young minds, schooling involves stress free and attractive methods such as:

- Development of the child's academic and technical skills with the help of modern learning devices such as Smart Boards, Computerized Programs in various subjects.

## MIDDLE SCHOOL (GRADE VI – VIII)

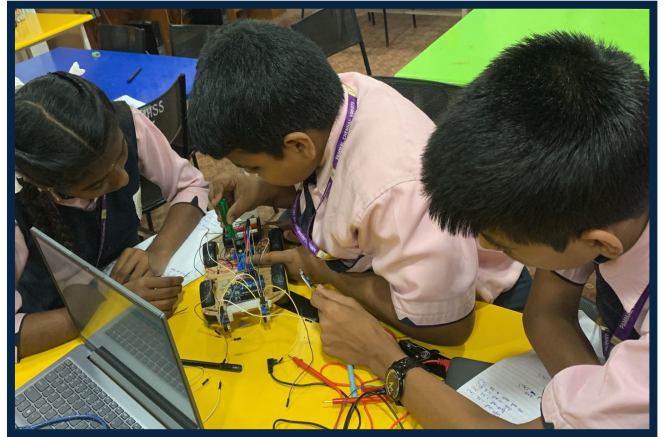

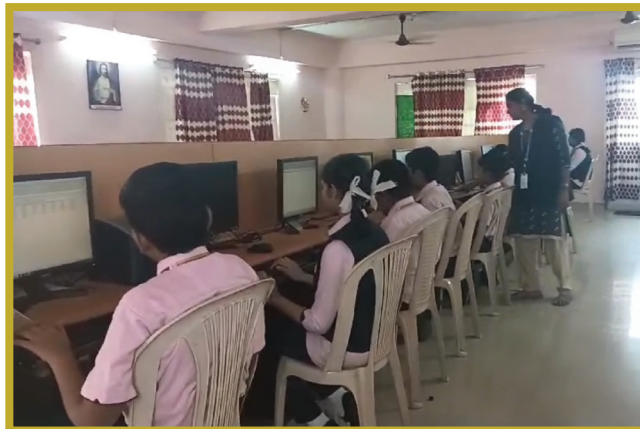

# ADMISSION

## [A] Admission Procedure

- I. No pupil will be admitted without the Transfer Certificate from the last school attended.  
The Transfer Certificate should be countersigned by the Inspector of Schools in case of those coming from States other than Tamilnadu.
- II. Students seeking admission into UKG to STD IX must take the entrance test.  
Selection will be made purely on merit.
- III. Students seeking admission in Std XI must take the entrance examination.
- IV. Children should have completed 3 years as on June 30th in order to qualify for admission to LKG.
- V. Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Any attempt to use influence, unfair means or recommendation for admission, will lead to automatic disqualification. The school does not have any agents for admission.

## [B] Documents to be produced (Xerox)

- I. Duly completed Registration form
- II. Birth Certificate
- III. If Catholic, Parish card and Baptism Certificate
- IV. Ration Card
- V. Aadhar Card (or) Rental Agreement
- VI. Students and Parents Passport size Photograph

- I. Original Transfer Certificate
- II. Community Certificate
- III. Duly Attested copy of Previous school Progress Report Card



## **TRANSFER CERTIFICATE**

- A requisition for the Transfer Certificate must be made before March 31st. The Transfer Certificate will be issued only on a requisition made by both the Parents / Guardians. It will be issued only when the fee has been paid in full.

## **CO-OPERATION OF PARENTS**

- The co-operation of all parents is expected in ensuring the students regular and punctual attendance, good general behavior and execution of home work.
- Parents should inspect the students' school diary regularly.
- Change of address of parent or guardian must be intimated to the school office in writing and without delay, failing which, the school will not be responsible for no receipt of communication addressed to the parent / guardian. Students who indulge in political propaganda or who organize fellow-students into political factions in the premises of the school or who otherwise engage themselves in party politics are liable to be expelled from the school.
- Students should not indulge in any activity leading to the disruption of peace and discipline of normal work in the school. Students found guilty of violation of this rule, will be severely dealt with.
- Ragging is strictly forbidden. Anyone who indulges in ragging will be severely dealt with.
- Students who are guilty of :
  - a) Rude language towards the staff of the school (or)
  - b) Assault or attempt to assault the staff or fellow students of the school are liable to be expelled from the institution.
- The principal or other constituted school authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character regulating the conduct outside the school, that seem necessary to maintain the credit, usefulness and reputation of the school. Parents are welcome to visit the school. However, they are requested not to enter the classroom during school hours without first consulting the Principal. Students will not be permitted to drive two wheelers or four wheelers to and from school. Parents are requested to abide by the Traffic rules laid down by the school. Parents are expected to be active members of the P.T.A. and are welcome to offer their assistance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
